- The assessment candidate must explain how an area allows for the following:
 - A sense of belonging: for example, family photos on the wall
 - Individual experience: for example, a tent with a cushion and a book for one child
 - Collaborative experience: for example, a large piece of paper on the fence with a range of spray bottles for the children to participate in a group painting
 - Unhurried activity: for example, a large piece of paper on the fence with a range of spray bottles for the children to participate in a group painting. Having an activity such as this allows there to be no time limits for the activity, as play can be completed before changing activities or moving on, it is suitable to offer over varying times and allows children to come and go from the activity
