1. List indicators about a child and their family that may indicate they need additional support from resources within the community.
2. Create a notice or computerised display that responds to a current topic of concern or interest for a parent or parents at your service. If you have no relevant topic currently, ask your supervisor or trainer/assessor to suggest one.
 - The display should focus on two organisations outside of your service that are able to support the topic and the parents needing assistance. It should aim to meet:
 - the National Quality Standard Element 6.1.3 ‘Current information is available to families about the service and relevant community services and resources to support parenting and family wellbeing’
 - Element 6.2.3 ‘The service builds relationships and engages with its community’.
 - Include in your display:
 - a clear heading so everyone knows what the topic is
 - current information about the topic
 - what assistance each organisation can offer the parents
 - a copy of any resources they provide
 - a list of resources that can be accessed
 - how the organisation and the resources can be accessed; for example, do they need a referral?
 - who to contact
 - any costs, fees or funding if relevant
 - if information is available in a language other than English.
